Job Description: Works to plan, coordinate and provide spiritual care for the congregation as a whole, especially adults, through Bible Studies, Fellowship and Service opportunities. The Board of Elders is also charged with caring for called workers and their spouses by working with them to prevent burn out and encouraging continued education.

Communicates with: Adults of Congregation, Adult Bible Study Leaders, Pastor and Early Childhood Director

## Requirements and Job Duties

- ✓ Attend Worship and Bible Study 75% of Sundays
- ✓ Male member of Peace Lutheran
- ✓ Able to attend 1.5 hour meeting every other month to discuss spiritual care of Pastor and Congregation
- ✓ Willing to listen to members of the church
- ✓ Willing to call on and at times visit inactive members of church
- ✓ Pray for called workers and members
